Paju City's siting process was doing smoothly, but Incheon City's process was not



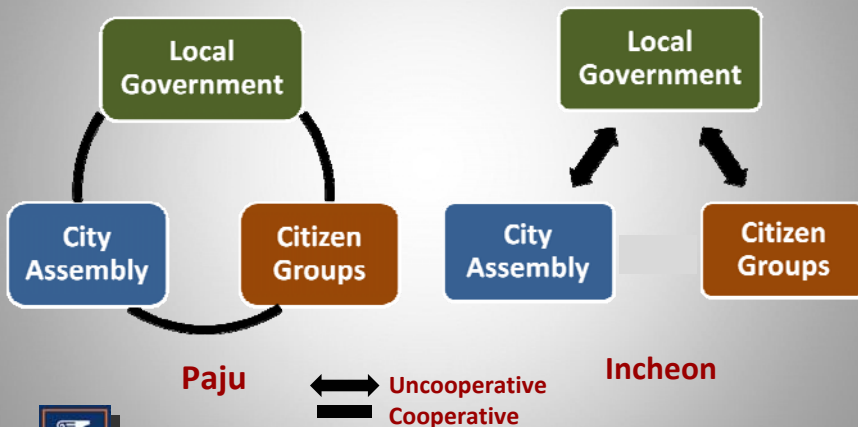

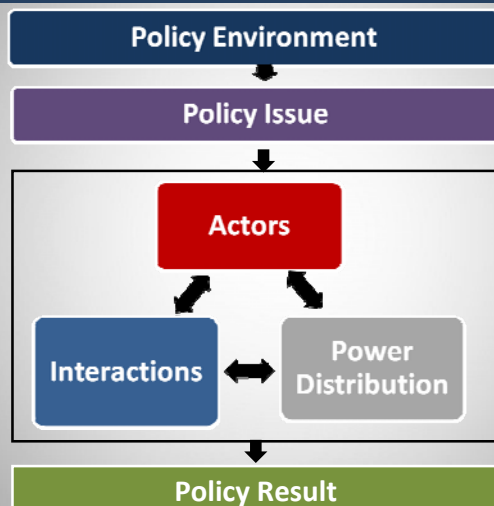
